

Petition to the Provincial Government of Ontario
Regarding the
Funding of Long Term Care Facilities

Whereas: The government has since the Harris government funded the private sector with incentives of \$100,000 per new long term care bed and,

Whereas: The majority of Ontarians' feel that private sector businesses should not have an arrangement for ongoing subsidization with taxpayer dollars and,

Whereas: The cost of providing Health Care, which includes long term care for an aging population, is of grave concern to all Ontarians because it will continue to take a larger portion of our provincial budget unless costs are managed properly,

Whereas: Not for profit long term care facilities have provided less expensive, more patient focused services and community pride we request that

Therefore be It Resolved: That the provincial government change the legislation so that the \$100,000 per bed that is provided to for profit developments is stopped and that this funding be provided for the not for profit sector.
